Installing & Using

Depending on model, country and equipment, registration processes and features of the Porsche Connect services may deviate.

Avoid distraction

If you use the PCM or other components in the vehicle while driving, you are distracted from the traffic and may not react in time to dangerous situations. For your safety, some functions are only available when the vehicle is stationary.

- Only use the multi-function steering wheel, infotainment system, etc. while driving if the traffic situation permits. In case of doubt, stop the vehicle when it is safe to do so.
- Do not use mobile phones or other mobile devices while driving.
- Always use hands-free equipment.
- Do not reach through the steering wheel spokes while driving. Otherwise, you may not be able to react in time to dangerous situations.

Registration and activation

Activating Porsche ID account and Porsche Connect Services

- E-mail for activation of the Porsche ID account was received.
- 1. Tap the "Activate Porsche ID Account" button in the invitation e-mail and enter the confirmation code that was sent to the stored mobile phone number.
- 2. Set a password and security code for the Porsche ID account.
- 3. Complete the profile information and activate

the free inclusive Porsche Connect period (availability dependent on country).

- The My Porsche start page or the app shows the 8-digit pairing code, which is required for using Porsche Connect services in your vehicle.
- To enter it in the vehicle, send the pairing code in My Porsche to the stored mobile phone number via text message.

i Information

- **Step 3.** takes place automatically in the background, depending on the country.
- If you have not received an e-mail for activating your Porsche ID, please contact your Porsche partner.

Activating additional services via My Porsche

Additional services that are subject to a charge can be activated at any time in the Porsche Connect Store.

- Porsche ID account activated.
- Log in to My Porsche with the Porsche ID. (Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on the country.)
- 2. Select the **Services** tab. Available services are displayed.
- **3.** Select and activate or configure the desired service.

Information

- In some countries, verification of customer identity is required for use of the embedded SIM card for legal reasons. For this purpose, customer identity must be checked by means of an identification document before activation of Porsche Connect services. Verification is performed by a third-party provider (IDnow) in the form of a video call.

Connecting & pairing the vehicle

Establishing data connection via embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country)

- The SIM card reader is empty.
- ✓ PCM phone is switched on. (SET Section > Porsche Connect > Switch on telephone function)

The data connection is established immediately when the ignition is switched on.

i Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched on.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
- Private mode is deactivated.
- Restart the PCM if necessary.

Displaying data packages

Information about the booked data package is displayed in some markets.

Establishing data connection via external SIM card

An inserted external SIM card deactivates the function of the embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country). Additional costs may be incurred for the data connection (e.g. due to data roaming).

NOTICE

If you are using a SIM card adapter, the SIM card may fall out of the adapter due to vibrations and components of the card may get stuck in the drive.

Do not use adapters for SIM cards.

- ✓ PCM phone is switched on. (SET Connect ► Switch on telephone function)
- Insert external SIM card B (mini-SIM, dimensions: 25 x 15 mm). The missing corner must be at the front left with the chip facing downwards.
- 2. SIM card with PIN:

- a. If necessary, enter the PIN for the external SIM card and confirm with **OK**.
- b. Select Store PIN.
- **3.** Confirm the prompt for establishing the data connection.

The data connection is established.

4. To remove the external SIM card, press on the inserted card and remove it.

i Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- PCM phone is switched on.
- External SIM card has sufficient data volume and is inserted correctly.
- External SIM card is not damaged and is working properly.
- APN settings (Internet access) are correct. The APN settings can be checked by contacting the network operator.
- Abroad: Data roaming is allowed on the external SIM card and enabled in the PCM.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage blackspot).
- Restart the PCM if necessary.

Selecting access point for external SIM card

If several access points are available, the message Several access points (APN) are available. Please select one appears. A list of available access points (APNs) is displayed.

- 1. Select the desired access point (APN).
- 2. If there is no access point configured, contact the mobile phone provider to obtain the APN settings. To configure the APN settings, select

Establishing data connection via an external WiFi hotspot (availability dependent on country)

- ✓ The SIM card reader is **empty**.
- ✓ Vehicles with embedded SIM card (availability dependent on country): PCM phone is switched

off. (SET ▲ ► Porsche Connect ► Switch off telephone function)

- Select or in the header (depending on the connection status) ➤ Options > WiFi ➤ Search for WiFi hotspot
- Select a WiFi hotspot (e.g. public hotspot or the mobile phone's personal hotspot) and enter WiFi access data in the PCM. When entering the data, pay attention to upper and lower case. A connection is established to the external WiFi hotspot.

Logging in Porsche ID

The Porsche ID is linked to the PCM using a pairing code. This is required for using some Connect services in order to retrieve personal settings from My Porsche.

- 1. APPS III ► Options E ► Porsche ID settings ► Link new Porsche ID
- 2. Enter the pairing code.
 - Please refer to chapter "Registration and activation" on page 3.

User is logged in and the symbol \blacksquare appears in the header.

Granting remote access authorisation

In order to use services that are controlled via My Porsche or the app, remote access authorisation must first be granted in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

- 1. SET 🔯 ► Porsche Connect
- 2. Select Remote access authorisation ► Grant remote access authorisation.
- 3. Confirm message window with Grant.
- 4. Enter the pairing code of the main user.

The **Private mode** function can be used to temporarily deactivate and reactivate remote access authorisation for **all** services or for **individual services**.

- 1. SET 🔯 ► Porsche Connect
- 2. Select Private mode ► On.

Communication between the vehicle and app as well as My Porsche is disabled.

Vehicle-specific information is not transmitted and no vehicle settings can be made via the app or My Porsche.

Security code

A security code must be set in order to use certain remote services via the app or My Porsche.

- Call up My Porsche. (Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country.)
- 2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
- **3.** The security code can be set, changed or reset in the user settings.

The **Security code** must be assigned for use of the following services:

- Opening and locking the vehicle via the app
- Deactivating the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS)
- Activation of remote functions for the secondary user

Logging Porsche ID out of PCM

- A Porsche Connect user is created and registered.
- 1. APPS I > Options Porsche ID settings
- 2. Select the desired Porsche user ► Porsche ID logout



- The Porsche Connect services (including the Car Connect services, but not the Safety and Security services) offer a free inclusive period, which varies in length for each services package and country, but is always at least 3 months. Further information about the free inclusive periods as well as subsequent costs and information about the availability of individual services for your country is available online at **www.porsche.com/ connect** or from your Porsche partner.
- Depending on the country, the Porsche Connect Services can be used via the embedded SIM or via a data-enabled, external SIM card. A separate, fee-based contract with a mobile phone provider is required for the external SIM card.
- You may incur additional charges when receiving data packages from the Internet, depending on your mobile phone tariff and whether you are abroad. A flat-rate data plan is recommended.
- The availability, scope and provider of the services may vary depending on the country, model year, device and tariff.

Apple CarPlay

Apple CarPlay makes iPhone apps available in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM). You can use the Siri voice recognition system to send and answer text messages as well as process voice commands.

Information

- We recommend that you install the latest iOS version.
- Only those apps in the iPhone that are supported by Apple CarPlay are displayed. For information on supported apps, go to www.apple.com/ios/ carplay.
- The function can only be offered in countries supported by Apple. For information on supported countries, go to: www.apple.com/ios/ feature-availability/#apple-carplay.
- The displayed content and features of the Apple CarPlay function are provided solely by the connected iPhone.
- When Apple CarPlay is used, any active Bluetooth[®] connections (e.g. for telephony, media playback or news) are automatically disconnected. An inserted external SIM card cannot be used for making calls while this app is in use.
- Some apps require an active data connection. _ You may incur additional charges, depending on your mobile phone tariff, and particularly if using abroad. The use of a flat-rate data plan is recommended.

Opening Apple CarPlay in the PCM



- Fig. 2: USB interface (type C) in armrest
- ✓ iPhone 7 or later, iOS 14 or higher.
- ✓ Siri and Apple CarPlav have been enabled in the settings of the iPhone that you are using.
- ✓ Use undamaged original cables from Apple without a USB adapter to ensure trouble-free use.
- 1. Connect your iPhone to the USB interface (type C) A in the armrest.
- 2. Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used. Apple CarPlay is opened. Available apps are displayed.
- To switch from another menu item to Apple CarPlay, select Apple CarPlay – or –

Select Apple CarPlay 💽 in the status bar.

Operating Apple CarPlay with PCM

All available apps can be operated via the touch display, the rotary push button and the Back button of the PCM.

- ► To call up the main menu in Apple CarPlay, select the Home button e on the PCM touch display.
- To switch to the main functions of the PCM. select Apple CarPlay ► Home button Porsche 🛃 .

Operating Apple CarPlay using Siri voice recognition

Starting Siri

- ✓ Siri has been enabled in the settings of the iPhone you are using.
- ✓ The ignition and PCM are switched on.
- ✓ No telephone call is in progress.
- ParkAssist is not active.
- PCM voice control is not active.

- ✓ Siri is active and waiting for a voice command.
- Press the (Q) button on the steering wheel.
 A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Switching between Apple CarPlay and use of the iPhone as an iPod

If the connected iPhone is connected as an iPod, Apple CarPlay is not available. You can switch between using the iPhone as an iPod and Apple CarPlay using the Device Manager.

1. To call up the Device Manager, select 🗾 or

in the header (depending on the connection status).

- 2. Select the Apple CarPlay icon for the iPhone you are using.
 - or –
 - Select the **iPod** icon of the iPhone you are using.

The icon of the currently active application of the iPhone is highlighted in colour

Calling up Wireless Apple CarPlay (availability dependent on country)

Wireless CarPlay allows you to use Apple CarPlay without a cable. Wireless CarPlay supports only one active mobile phone at a time.

- Bluetooth[®] and WiFi functions activated on the mobile phone and visible to other devices.
- ✓ Wireless CarPlay activated on mobile phone.

- Bluetooth[®] and WiFi functions of the vehicle activated.
- In the or status area (depending on your connection status) and in the connection assistant menu, select > Apple CarPlay Search.
 or -

2. Select the device from the list.

 Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used. Apple CarPlay is opened. Available Apps are displayed.

After you have connected your iPhone once, Apple CarPlay starts automatically whenever you get into the vehicle. This way, your mobile phone can stay in your bag, pocket or similar (Bluetooth[®] and WiFi functions must be enabled).

Alternatively, Wireless CarPlay can be reconnected via:

2. Select the Symbol on the iPhone that you are using.

To switch from another menu item to Apple CarPlay:

Removing a saved iPhone from the device list

Ending Wireless CarPlay

- 1. Select Devices 🔜
- Select the symbol on the iPhone that you are using.
 Wireless CarPlay is ended.

Dictation

You can use the **Dictation** service to record a message via voice control.

This service is not available in all languages and markets, and depends on the mobile phone used. Voice control can be interrupted in order to say other voice commands. Activating/deactivating voice control interruption in the PCM:

Select SET System settings > Voice control ► Interrupt voice control.

Connecting mobile phone via Bluetooth®

- ✓ Mobile phone's Bluetooth[®] function is activated and visible to other devices.
- The PCM's Bluetooth[®] function is activated.
- 1. Select or **Search for new device** in the header.
- 2. Select a mobile phone from the device list. A 6-digit Bluetooth® code is generated and displayed in the PCM and on the mobile phone.
- 3. Compare the Bluetooth® code in the PCM and on the mobile phone.
- 4. If the Bluetooth[®] code in the mobile phone match, confirm. Enter the PIN for the external SIM card in the PCM if necessary. When the phone is successfully connected, the numeric input (KEYPAD 🔠 menu) is displayed in the PCM.



- Depending on the Bluetooth® capability of the mobile phone, it is possible to access the content of the phone book, call lists and messages. It is also possible to transfer a current call to the mobile phone after stopping the vehicle and continue it outside the vehicle if the mobile phone supports this function.
- You will find an overview of compatible mobile phones on the Porsche website for your country under: Models ► Your model (e.g. 911 Carrera) ► Download Brochures ► Via Bluetooth[®].

Connecting a mobile phone (Windows[®] and iOS operating system)

For mobile phones with Windows[®] and iOS operating systems, we recommend initiating the connection from the mobile phone:

- **1.** Search for available devices in the mobile phone's Bluetooth[®] menu. Press 📈 or 📶 in the header (depending on the connection status) to make the PCM visible.
- Select the PCM from the list of available devices. The Bluetooth[®] device name of the PCM can be displayed by selecting Device manager under

Options **E** > Bluetooth > Bluetooth name.

Calling up voice control



Impaired voice recognition

Your voice may change in stressful situations. This can lead to the desired telephone connection failing or not being established guickly enough under

certain circumstances.

- Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- Dial the emergency number using the touch display.

Activating voice control

- Ignition switched on.
- ✓ No telephone call is in progress.
- Parking aid is not active.
- **1.** Briefly press the $\mathbb{Q}^{\mathbb{Q}}$ button on the steering wheel.

A rising acoustic signal sounds and the icon for voice control appears in the PCM.


2. Say the voice command.

Deactivating voice control

- Voice control is active.
- Press the Q button on the steering wheel. A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Other functions of the voice control button

The ${}_{(k)}Q$ button on the control stalk can activate different functions, depending on the application:

- Skips a running announcement when pressed briefly.
- Interrupts the current dialogue when pressed briefly.
- Activates the Siri voice control system through a longer press.

i Information

- Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not given during a dialogue.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected via voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, voice control responds with the question Excuse me? and the voice command can then be repeated.

Notes on communication using voice control

Observe the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control function is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive sounds caused by closing doors, windows and sliding roof, for example.
- Only the driver should issue voice commands, as the hands-free microphone is pointed towards the driver's side.

Dictating and reading out messages

You can use the **Dictation** service to dictate text messages or e-mails, for example, and play incoming messages from the PCM.

- Data connection established.
- Porsche Connect services activated in My Porsche.

- The connected mobile phone supports the function.
- ✓ Voice control is active.

Dictating messages

Service cannot be used with Apple devices.

Say the voice command:
 Dictate (new) e-mail
 or –

Dictate (new) text message

The dictated message is displayed in the PCM for the user to check.

Reading out messages

 Say the voice command: Read out e-mails

– or –

Read out text messages

The message is read out.

Finder

The **Finder** is the central search function in the Porsche Communication Managements (PCM) navigation. Information about the destination, such as restaurants, hotels, petrol stations or car parks, can be called up in Finder.

The destinations can be displayed in the current area, along the route, at the destination or at another location. The selected destination can be adopted as a navigation destination and saved as a favourite.

- Data connection established.

- Select NAV M ► P in the header. You can switch between integrated search in the PCM memory and online content as well as online Internet search via the globe and Google icon next to the input line.
- 2. Select destination.

Information such as availability, price information and ratings is displayed (availability dependent on country).

My Porsche

My Porsche is the central platform for managing your vehicles and using relevant services and is the starting point for other available functions and services. Access to My Porsche is via your personal Porsche ID. You can implement personal settings relating to data synchronisation and data processing in your Porsche ID account.

The platform also offers various other options, e.g. the possibility to arrange service appointments.

The services and functions that are available depend on the model, country and equipment.

Logging into My Porsche

- Email for registration at My Porsche has been received.
- Porsche ID account activated.
- Open My Porsche. (Access in the menu at the top of the Porsche website.)
- 2. Enter login data (Porsche ID and password) and open My Porsche.

i Information

- **Step 3.** takes place automatically in the background, depending on the country.
- If you have not received an e-mail for activating your Porsche ID, please contact your Porsche partner.

Configuring services

- Email for registration at My Porsche has been received.
- Porsche ID account activated.

- Porsche ID logged into My Porsche.
- 1. Select **Services** in the My Porsche tab. Available services are displayed.
- 2. Select the desired service.
- 3. Configure the service.

Adding a navigation destination

- Email for registration at My Porsche has been received.
- Porsche ID account activated.
- Porsche ID logged into My Porsche.
- 1. Select **Services** in the My Porsche tab. Available services are displayed.
- 2. Select the Navigation Plus service.
- 3. Select Add new destination.
- Enter destination data. The destination is displayed in My Porsche and can be edited, marked, deleted or sent to the vehicle.

Real-time traffic

With the **Real-time traffic** service, the current traffic situation is accessed online in real time and the roads are shown in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) marked in colour according to the traffic situation.

The following traffic flow information is displayed:

- Free lines: freely flowing traffic _
- Yellow lines: slow-moving traffic
- Red lines: traffic iam
- Dark red lines: closed road

In addition, notifications regarding roadworks, accidents, black spots etc. are displayed.

Activating real-time traffic

- Data connection established.
- Porsche Connect services activated in My Porsche.

1. NAV 🚺 > MAP 🔟 > Options 🔚 > Navigation settings

2. Select Online navigation services ► Online navigation.

When route guidance is active, messages are displayed in the navigation map. A status

symbol e appears in the header when realtime traffic is active.

Calling up a real-time traffic notice

By opening a real-time traffic notice you can display details of the relevant notice.

- Data connection established.
- Porsche Connect services activated in Mv Porsche.
 - ⊳ Please refer to chapter "Installing & Using" on page 3.
- Online navigation activated.
 - Please refer to chapter "Activating online ⊳ routing" on page 13.
- 1. Select 🔼 in the map. A brief overview with route information, time delay and type of fault will be displayed.
- 2. Tap Brief Overview. Detailed information is displayed on the left edge of the PCM.

My Destinations

Using My Porsche or the app, it is possible to store destinations, which can be retrieved directly in the PCM.

- Data connection established.
- Porsche Connect services activated in My Porsche.

- Pairing code entered in the PCM.
 - Please refer to chapter "Installing & Using" on page 3.
- 1. Select NAV 🚺 ► FAV 🔜

- The destinations and favourites stored in My Porsche or via the app are displayed.
- 2. Select destination and Start route guidance.

Online destinations that were stored under My Destinations, are deleted after 30 days.

Online Routing

With the Online Routing option, additional online data is used in the route calculation in order to enable enhanced route guidance.

Under the menu item Satellite Map. satellite data for displaying aerial images of buildings, roads and terrain can be used.

News

You can use the **News** service to display selected news feeds (news channels) or subscribed **Twitter** tweets in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) according to your interests. You can have news and subscribed tweets read out from the PCM using voice control.

Configuring news and Twitter in My Porsche

Five news feed channels are predefined in the PCM by default. Other news feeds can be added individually via My Porsche.

- Call up My Porsche. (Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country.)
- 2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
- 3. Select Services ► News
- 4. Select the desired option:
- New ±: For adding new news feeds to the list.
- Search : For locating individual news feeds in the news list.
- Delete : For deleting individual news feeds from the list.
- Pencil icon O: For editing news feeds that have already been added.

Adding a new news feed

- 2. Enter the URL of a message portal in the input field.

A suggested list of suitable news feeds is displayed.

Porsche Connect app¹

The app, which is available in some countries, can be used to network the mobile phone with the vehicle. This allows vehicle-specific information to be retrieved directly via the cellphone and selected vehicle settings to be made from the app.

Setting and operating while driving

Operating and making settings for the app while driving could distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

 Operate and adjust settings only while the vehicle is stationary.

Personal POIs (Points of Interest), destinations from the address book or calendar entries, for example, can be transferred to the PCM from the mobile phone.

Installing & using App

Log Porsche ID into the app




Fig. 11: Opening Device Manager

If the vehicle alarm system is triggered, a Push notification with information on the type and time of the alarm is sent directly to the mobile phone.

Location, speed and valet alarm

- Location: A geographical area can be defined. If the vehicle enters or leaves this area, an alarm message is sent.

Geographical areas and limit speeds can be added and activated via the **Add alarm** function.

Stored geographical areas and limit speeds can be edited or deleted via the **Edit** function.



Changes to limit settings affect all app users that access the same vehicle.

Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS)

The functions of the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS) can be remotely activated/deactivated using the app.

The following special modes are available:

- Service mode: When the mode is activated, no theft alarm is triggered if the vehicle is being serviced (e.g. battery is disconnected).
- Transport mode: When the mode is activated, no theft alarm is triggered if the vehicle is moved with the ignition switched off (e.g. on a ferry).
- Disarmed mode (PVTS Plus): When the mode is activated, monitoring of the Driver Card is deactivated so that a missing Driver Card no longer triggers an alarm.

Please use these functions carefully.

 Activation of the special modes temporarily restricts the security of your vehicle.

PVTS or PVTS Plus depends on the vehicle equipment.

With the **Radio Plus** service, it is possible to switch between the Internet radio and the hybrid radio. The Internet radio receives radio stations online, the hybrid radio automatically selects the best possible reception.

Voice Pilot

You can use the **Voice Pilot** service to operate selected functions in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) system by voice command. The **Voice Pilot** service is not available in all languages and markets.

Voice control can be interrupted in order to say other voice commands. Activating/deactivating voice control interruption in the PCM:

 Select SET System settings > Voice control > Interrupt voice control.

Opening voice control

Impaired voice recognition

Your voice may change in stressful situations. This can lead to the desired telephone connection failing or not being established quickly enough under certain circumstances.

- Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- Dial the emergency number using the touch display.




Fig. 14: Voice control button on the steering wheel

A rising acoustic signal is heard and the symbol

- for voice control appears in the PCM.

Deactivating voice control

Information

The dialogue can be paused by tapping on the microphone symbol 🚺 and started again by tapping again.

Other functions of the voice control button

- Skips a running announcement when pressed briefly.
- Interrupts the current dialogue when pressed briefly.
- Activates the Siri voice control system through a longer press.



Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not given during a dialogue.

- With voice control active, list entries can be selected via voice control, the rotary push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, voice control responds with the question Excuse me? and the voice command can then be repeated.

Notes on communication using voice control

Note the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Do not speak when the voice control function is making an announcement.
- Reduce disruptive sounds caused by closing doors, windows and sliding roof, for example.
- Only the driver should issue voice commands, as the hands-free microphone is pointed towards the driver's side.




Fig. 15: Weather




Fig. 16: Rain Radar
