Registering and setting up

Important notes on Porsche Connect

Availability

Depending on the country and equipment, different Porsche Connect options are available. The contents described here may differ accordingly.

Data connection

A data connection is required in order to use the Porsche Connect services. Depending on the country, the data connection can be established via the integrated SIM card or an external WiFi hotspot.

Information

In some countries, verification of customer identity is required for use of the embedded SIM card for legal reasons. For this purpose, customer identity must be checked by means of an identification document before activation of the Porsche Connect services. Verification is performed by a third-party provider (IDnow) in the form of a video call.

The current active data connection is displayed in the status area of the PCM and in the Device Manager.

Use while driving

If the PCM or other components in the vehicle are operated while driving, there is a risk of distraction from the driving action and it may not be possible to react to dangerous situations in time. For this reason, some functions are only available when the unit is stationary.

1. Only use the multi-function steering wheel, infotainment system etc. while driving if the traffic situation permits. In case of doubt, stop the vehicle when it is safe to do so.
2. Do not use mobile phones or other mobile devices while driving.

3. Always use hands-free equipment.
4. Do not reach through the steering wheel spokes while driving. Otherwise, you may not be able to react in time to dangerous situations.

Apps

Various apps are available for your vehicle, depending on the country (download from Apple App Store or GOOGLE Play Store).

WARNING

Using and operating while driving

Setting and operating apps while driving may distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

- Only use and operate apps when the vehicle is stationary.

Registering and activating My Porsche

My Porsche is the central platform for managing his personal vehicles and using relevant services and is the starting point for other available functions and services. Access to My Porsche is via the personal Porsche ID.

The Porsche ID is a verified e-mail address that is used as the Porsche Connect user in My Porsche, the Porsche Connect Store and My Porsche app.

In the Porsche ID account, the user can make personal settings relating to data synchronisation and data processing. The platform also offers various other options, e.g. the possibility to arrange service appointments.

The services and functions that are available depend on the country and equipment.

Logging into My Porsche

- ✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche.
(Displayed at the top left of the Porsche website, depending on country.)
2. Enter login data (Porsche ID and password) and open My Porsche.

Porsche ID account (Porsche Connect User) and activate Porsche Connect Services

- ✓ E-mail for activation of the Porsche ID account was received.

1. Click the "Activate Porsche ID Account" button in the e-mail and enter the confirmation code (sent to the stored mobile phone number).
2. Set a **password** and **security code** for your Porsche ID account.
3. Complete the profile information and activate the free inclusive Porsche Connect period (takes place automatically in the background, depending on the country)

Information

If no e-mail for activating the Porsche ID was received, please contact the responsible Porsche partner.

Security code

A security code must be set in order to successfully log in with the Porsche ID in the vehicle and to use some remote services via the app or My Porsche.

1. My Porsche Open.
2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. The security code can be set, changed or reset in the user settings.

The **security code** must be issued depending on the country, such as for the use of the following services:

- Unblocking of Porsche ID after vehicle entry (if "Login with security code" is set)
- Change the login settings in the vehicle (e.g. to "Login without security code")
- Deactivating the Porsche Vehicle Tracking System (PVTS)
- Activation of remote functions for the secondary user

Configure services

- ✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche.
2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select the **Services** tab.
➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select the desired service.
5. Activate and configure the system.

Information

- The Porsche Connect service package offers a wide range of Porsche Connect services for a free, inclusive period, which may vary in length for each service and country. More information about the free, inclusive periods and subsequent costs along with information about the availa-



bility of individual services for your country is available online at www.porsche.com/connect or from your Porsche partner.

- Depending on the country, Porsche Connect services can be used via the embedded SIM card or the external WiFi hotspot (only available in Russia).
- You may incur additional charges when receiving data packages from the Internet, depending on your mobile phone tariff and whether you are abroad. A flat-rate data plan is recommended. The availability, scope and provider of the services may vary depending on the country, model year, device and tariff.

Porsche ID (Porsche Connect user) login in the vehicle

You must log in with the Porsche ID in the vehicle to use some Porsche Connect Services. Logging in allows you to access My Porsche personal settings in the vehicle.

- ✓ A Porsche Connect user (Porsche ID) is registered in My Porsche .
- ✓ Security code (see ▷ Refer to chapter "Security code" on 4 page.Porsche ID security code created in My Porsche and known.

2. Enter your Porsche ID e-mail address and My Porsche password and confirm with **Login**.

Adding a navigation destination

Navigation destinations can be defined either in the My Porsche portal or directly in the vehicle.

Adding navigation destination in My Porsche

✓ Porsche ID account is activated.

1. Open My Porsche.
2. Log in using your personal access data (Porsche ID and password).
3. Select the **Services** tab.
 - ➔ Available services are displayed.
4. Select the **Navigation Plus** service.
5. Select **Add new destination**.
6. Enter destination data.
 - ➔ The destination is displayed in My Porsche and can be edited, selected, deleted or sent to the vehicle.

Establishing data connection

Establishing data connection via embedded SIM card

Establishing a data connection via the embedded SIM card is available depending on country.

- ✓ Private mode deactivated.
▷ P. 7

The data connection is established automatically when operational readiness is established.

Information

If a data connection cannot be established, check the following:

- Private mode deactivated.
- The vehicle is in an area with sufficient network reception (not a coverage black spot).

- ▷ Restart the PCM if necessary.

Establishing data connection via external WiFi hotspot

Establishing a data connection via an external WiFi hotspot is currently only available in Russia.

Information

Data connections via external WiFi hotspots can cause additional costs (e.g. due to data roaming).

- ✓ Mobile phone WiFi hotspot or public hotspot available.

1. Select **Device Manager** ▶ **Connect new devices** ▶ **Connect vehicle to WiFi network**.

- ➔ WiFi networks are searched for and displayed.

2. Select a WiFi hotspot (e.g. public hotspot or the mobile phone's WiFi hotspot) and enter WiFi access data in the PCM. When entering the data, pay attention to upper and lower case.
➔ A connection is established to the external WiFi hotspot.

Book data package

Data packages must be booked in order to establish an Internet connection for the WiFi hotspot.

- ✓ Data connection is successfully established via an integrated SIM card.
- ✓ For the relevant data package, please visit
▷ www.porsche.com/connect
or contact your local mobile phone provider.

Once a data package has been used up, a message appears automatically on the PCM.

Activating the PCM WiFi hotspot

Up to eight WiFi devices can be connected to the vehicle hotspot.

- ✓ Data package registered
- ✓ WiFi functions activated on the mobile phone and visible to other devices.

1. Select **Device Manager** ▶ **Connect new devices** ▶ **Connect device to vehicle hotspot**

- ➔ The device name and WiFi password of the are PCM displayed in the PCM.

2. Enter the displayed WiFi access data in the WiFi settings of the PCM.
– or –
Scan the QR code PCM displayed in the device.

- ➔ A connection is established to the PCM wireless internet access.

Managing and adjusting



Managing Porsche ID (Porsche Connect user)

✓ Porsche ID (Porsche Connect user) logged in.

▶  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Accounts** Select account
... ▶ **Complete action:**

- **Login with security code:** When operational readiness is established or the account is changed, the Porsche ID and the security code must be confirmed.
- **Login without security code:** When operational readiness is established or the account is changed, it is only necessary to confirm the Porsche ID.
- **Automatic login:** When operational readiness is established or the account is changed, the Porsche ID is logged in automatically without needing to be reconfirmed.
- **Deleting account:** The Porsche ID is deleted in the vehicle.
- **Deregister account:** The Porsche ID is logged out in the vehicle. The guest account is activated.



Displaying service overview

➔ Information about the services purchased and contract duration is displayed.

Granting remote access authorisation

Remote access authorisation is required in order to use service control programmes in My Porsche or the Porsche Connect App (availability depending on country) in the vehicle. Remote access authorisation is granted automatically as soon as the main user logs into the vehicle for the first time.

✓ Main user logged into the vehicle at least once.

Activate private mode

The availability of activating Private mode is dependent on the country.

Communication between the vehicle and the Porsche Connect App as well as My Porsche is disabled when private mode is active. No vehicle-specific information is transmitted. This means that no vehicle settings can be configured using the app or My Porsche.

✓ Remote access authorisation granted.

▶  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Privacy and Porsche Connect settings** ▶ **Privacy mode**
➔ Private mode can be activated or deactivated globally, for individual services or for service groups.

Despite activated privacy mode, location information for the vehicle can be transmitted in the event of a breakdown or emergency call as well as theft.

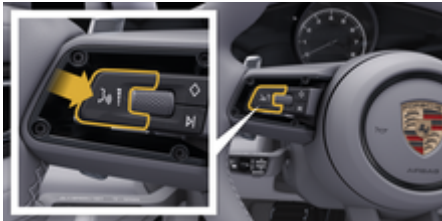



Fig. 2: Voice control button on the steering wheel

2. Say the desired voice command.

Exit Google Assistant







Open Wireless Android Auto

Wireless Android Auto (availability dependent on equipment and country) allows the use of Android Auto without cable. Wireless Android Auto only ever supports one active phone.




- ✓ Bluetooth® and WiFi functions activated on the mobile phone and visible to other devices.
- ✓ Wireless Android Auto enabled on the phone.
- ✓ Bluetooth® and WiFi functions of the vehicle activated.

1. In the status area, select  or  (depending on the connection status) and in the connection assistant menu select **Android Auto**  ▶ **Search**.
– or –
Tap Devices  ▶ **Android Auto** .
– or –
Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel until the search begins.

2. Select the device from the list.
3. Confirm notice that Android Auto is being used.
 - ➔ Opening Android Auto. Available apps are displayed.

Once the phone has been connected, Android Auto starts automatically as soon as the phone is in the vehicle.



Alternatively, **Wireless CarPlay** can be connected as follows:

2. Select the icon  for the phone you are using.

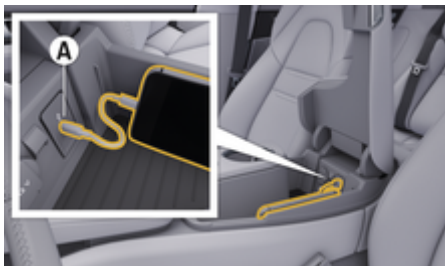




Fig. 3: USB interface (Type C) in armrest

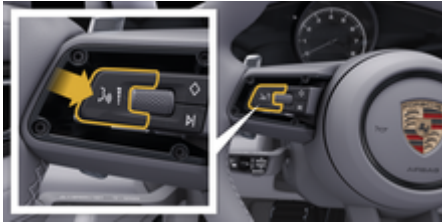



Fig. 4: Voice control button on the steering wheel








Switching between Apple CarPlay and using the iPhone as an iPod


If the connected iPhone is connected as an iPod, Apple CarPlay is not available. Use the Device Manager to switch between using the iPhone as an iPod and Apple CarPlay.

1. To open the Device Manager, select  or  (depending on the connection status) in the status area.
 - or –
 -  ▶ **Tap Devices**  select.
2. Select the **Apple CarPlay**  symbol on your iPhone.
 - or –
 - Select the **iPOD**  symbol on your iPhone used.
 - ➔ The icon or currently active application of your iPhone is highlighted in colour and shows the current connection (**Apple CarPlay** or **iPod**).

Open Wireless Apple CarPlay

Wireless Android Auto (availability dependent on equipment and country) allows the use of Apple CarPlay without a cable. Wireless CarPlay only ever supports one active mobile phone at a time.



- ✓ Bluetooth® and WiFi functions activated on the mobile phone and visible to other devices.
- ✓ Wireless CarPlay activated on the mobile phone.
- ✓ Siri activated on the mobile phone.
- ✓ Bluetooth® and WiFi functions of the vehicle activated.

1. Select  ▶ **Connect Apple CarPlay** ▶ in the status area New device.
 - ➔ Searching for a new device.
2. Select the vehicle in the mobile phone settings and confirm the message about establishing a connection.

Allow the synchronisation of contacts and favourites if desired.
3. Confirm pairing of the device in the PCM.
4. Confirm that Apple CarPlay is being used.
 - ➔ Apple CarPlay is opened. Available apps are displayed.




After you have connected your iPhone once, Apple CarPlay will start automatically whenever you enter the vehicle. You can therefore leave the mobile phone in your bag or trouser pocket, for example. (Bluetooth® and WiFi functions must be activated).

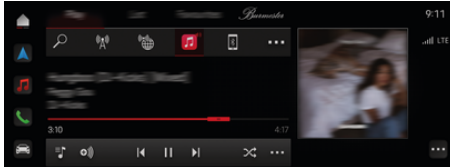





Fig. 5: Apple Music

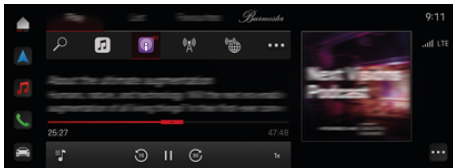


Fig. 6: Apple Podcasts

Finder

The **Finder** is the central search function in the Porsche Communication Managements (PCM) navigation. Information about destinations such as restaurants, hotels, car parks, charging stations or petrol stations can be called up in the Finder.

The destinations can be displayed in the current area, along the route or at the destination online. The selected destination can be adopted as a navigation destination and saved as a favourite.






My Porsche app

Installing and using the app

The app, which is available in some countries, can be used to network the mobile phone with the vehicle (name and functions subject to change). This allows vehicle-specific information to be retrieved directly via the mobile phone and selected vehicle settings to be made via the app. In addition, the breakdown call can be triggered in the app, depending on the country. For example, the following functions are available: Retrieve current vehicle data, such as range and fuel level or battery status, control locking and unlocking of the vehicle remotely, activate and deactivate air conditioning or pre-heater, manage personal POIs (points of interest) and send them to the vehicle, transfer destinations from calendar entries from the mobile phone to the PCM. In addition, the app provides access to current information about the Porsche brand, such as product features or events.





The availability of app functions depends on the respective vehicle model, model year, vehicle equipment and the local availability of the respective function in the market.

Connecting the app to the PCM via WiFi

The app enables access to vehicle-specific data and other functions. It is recommended that these data be protected from unauthorised access by third parties. Use of the app may incur additional costs with your service provider, as the data are transmitted via mobile phone networks.

- ✓ The app is installed on your mobile phone (download from Apple App Store or Google Play Store).
- ✓ App started.

- ✓ WiFi enabled on the mobile phone.
- ✓ WiFi function of the PCM activated.

Pre-heater



Inhalation of toxic exhaust gases

The pre-heater burns fuel when switched on. This produces toxic exhaust gases, which are released on the underside of the vehicle.

- Do not operate the pre-heater in enclosed spaces (e.g. in a garage).



Hot exhaust gases

The emissions produced during pre-heater operation are extremely hot.

- Switch off the pre-heater before refuelling.
- Park the vehicle so that hot exhaust gases can be discharged without obstruction on the underside of the body and cannot come into contact with easily combustible materials such as grass or leaves.

The auxiliary heater can be used to heat the interior of the vehicle and defrost the windscreen when the engine is not running. Using this function, the vehicle's auxiliary heater can be operated by remote control.

The pre-heater is deactivated after the running time and is only available again after the engine has been started.





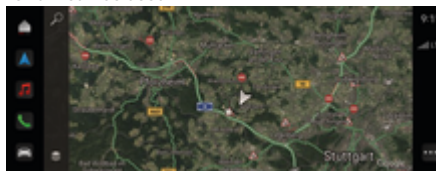


Fig. 10: Satellite map display

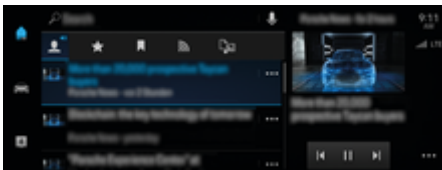




Fig. 11: Using the voice function for news

The download is paused when the vehicle is switched off and automatically resumed when it is switched on. The download time depends on the connection quality and the content. Once the download is complete, the installation can be started.

Installing online software update

When ready for installation, a message about the available online software update appears once and whenever the PCM is restarted. The message can be displayed at any time in the notifications.

- ▶ For information about the online software update, select **Updates** 

NOTICE

Usage restrictions during the online software update.

The vehicle is not ready to drive and must not be started. Displays and vehicle functions (e.g. comfort functions or anti-theft functions) may be temporarily disabled.

- ▶ Park the vehicle safely.
- ▶ Follow requests in the PCM, e.g. Leave the vehicle with all occupants.
- ▶ Do **not** use the vehicle during the online software update.
- ▶ Only use the vehicle after installation.

Only one installation process can be started. This installation process **cannot** be interrupted. The installation time depends on the content of the online software update. An installed online software update **cannot** be undone.

- ✓ Parking lock and parking brake activated.
- ✓ Battery charged sufficiently.
- ✓ It is possible that further conditions may be necessary (doors closed, vehicle locked); these conditions are shown in the PCM.

- ▶ Confirm installation of the online software update by **Install now**.

After restoring operational readiness, a notice appears once in the PCM). Full use of the vehicle is possible again.

Information

The installation time is automatically postponed in the absence of the installation confirmation or with **Remind me later**.

Online software update failed

Faults may occur while performing online software updates.

The severity of the fault caused and its consequences are shown in the PCM.

If faults occur, please observe the relevant instructions in the PCM.

NOTICE

Damage and usage restriction due to failed online software updates.

Displays and vehicle functions cannot function correctly.

- ▶ If the vehicle is ready for operation: Adapt your driving style to the situation.
- ▶ If the vehicle is not ready for operation: Call roadside assistance and have your vehicle towed.
- ▶ Have the fault corrected at a qualified specialist workshop. Porsche recommends a Porsche partner as they have trained workshop personnel and the necessary parts and tools.

Radio Plus

With the **Radio Plus** service, it is possible to switch between the integrated Internet radio and the hybrid radio. The Internet radio receives radio stations online, the hybrid radio automatically selects the best possible reception.

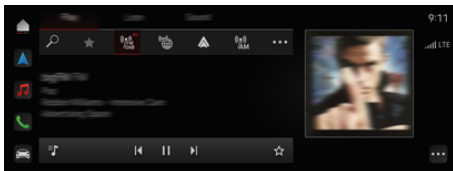


Fig. 12: Radio Plus

Opening Internet radio

With the Internet radio integrated in the PCM, online channels of radio stations can be received.

Station categorisation

The Internet radio stations can be selected according to the categories popularity, country, genre and language.

1. Select ▶ **Media** ▶ **tap Internet radio** ▶ **List**.
2. Select the desired category, e.g. ▶ **Genre**.

Activating hybrid radio

The **Hybrid radio** function enables continuous perfect reception. If the DAB or FM reception is subject to environmental interference, the PCM automatically receives the radio station online when the function is active.

- ✓ Media source **DAB/FM** is selected.

- ▶ ▶ **Media** ▶ ... ▶ **Radio settings** ▶ **Online station tracking**.
 - ➔ If the reception is poor, stations are automatically received **online**, and appears next to the station name.

Activating/deactivating online additional data

With this option, additional metadata and album covers are displayed.

- ▶ **Tap** ▶ **Settings** ▶ **Media** ▶ **Online additional data**.

Through the networking of vehicles, separate anonymised information from other vehicles can be accessed. The PCM can therefore inform the driver of dangers in advance.

Using and operating while driving

Setting and operating the multi-function steering wheel, infotainment system etc. while driving may distract you from the traffic situation. You may lose control of the vehicle.

- ▶ Operate the equipment while driving only if the traffic situation allows you to do so safely.
- ▶ In case of doubt, park the vehicle safely and only perform extensive operations and settings while the vehicle is stationary.

Functions

Some components in the vehicle require regular maintenance or replacement. Maintenance and repair data can be retrieved and updated with the Smart Service (availability dependent on country). If maintenance or repair of the components is necessary, a message appears on the PCM.

Activating Smart Service

Activation takes place as part of the Connect Care package in the Connect Store. The function is then automatically available in the vehicle.

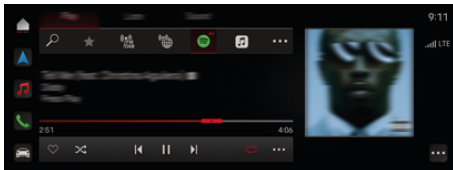




Fig. 14: Spotify



Voice control

Due to the various usage options, the features described here are not available in all models, countries and equipment versions.

⚠ WARNING

Impaired voice recognition

Your voice may change in stressful situations. In certain circumstances, this can cause the desired telephone connection to fail or not be established quickly enough.

- ▶ Do not use voice control in an emergency.
- ▶ Enter the emergency number via the PCM.

Voice control communicates with the driver, helping with use of the vehicle and performing various tasks while you are driving.

It is your helpful companion and can be used interactively. Voice control acts on and reacts to voice input, makes suggestions, performs searches based on your queries and incorporates environmental data.


Selected Precool/heat, Ergonomics, Media, Navigation and Phone functions can be activated, and controlled and used simply and easily via voice commands.

Voice control also offers a Help function.


Online mode

- ✓ Porsche Connect is activated in My Porsche.
- ✓ Data transfer to the cloud permitted.
- ✓ Data connection sufficient.
- ✓ Voice control is active.

The entire range of voice control functions can be accessed in online mode.

Online mode is indicated in PCM by the  symbol on the central display.

If the data connection is insufficient, PCM switches automatically to offline mode. In offline mode, some voice control functions are only available to a limited extent.

If voice control is in offline mode, this is indicated in PCM by the  symbol on the central display.

Using voice control

- ✓ Ignition is switched on.
- ✓ No reverse gear selected.
- ✓ No phone call active.
- ✓ Parking assistant is not active.

Starting voice control via the steering wheel

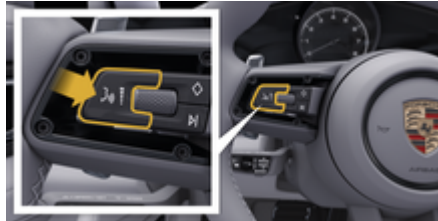








Fig. 15: Steering wheel with voice control button

1. Press the  button on the steering wheel.
 - ➔ An acoustic signal sounds and a window opens in PCM.
2. Say the voice command.


Start voice control via PCM

1.  ▶ **in the search area**  ▶ .
 - ➔ An input request sounds and a window opens in the PCM.
2. Say the voice command.
 - ➔ The search results are limited to the currently selected quick filter bar; e.g. if the **Media** quick filter bar is selected, only search results for this quick filter bar are displayed.



Starting voice control by saying "Hey Porsche"

- ✓ "Hey Porsche" activated:
1.  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Voice control** ▶ **Activating with "Hey Porsche"**
 2. Say "**Hey Porsche**" and the desired voice command.

Pausing voice control


- ✓ Voice control is active and waiting for a voice command.
- ▶  Tap in PCM.
 - ➔ The dialogue is paused and can be restarted by tapping again.

Ending voice control

- ✓ Voice control is active and waiting for a voice command.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel.
 - or –
 - Say **Cancel**.
 - or –
 - Touch outside of the window.
 - or –
 - Tap  in PCM.
- ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.


Interrupting voice control via a button

The voice output of the voice control can be interrupted during the dialogue.

- ▶ Briefly press the  button on the steering wheel.


Interrupting voice commands via voice input

The voice commands of voice control can be interrupted during the dialogue, e.g. so that other voice commands can be given or executed immediately. Activate the function in PCM:


- ▶ Tap  ▶ **Settings**  ▶ **Voice control** ▶ **Interrupt voice control**.

Starting external voice control (e.g. Siri) or Google Assistant)

1. Press and hold the  button on the steering wheel.
2. Say the desired voice command.

Ending external voice control (e.g. Siri) or Google Assistant)

- ▶ Refer to chapter "Apple CarPlay" on 10 page.
- ▶ Press the  button on the steering wheel.
 - ➔ A fading acoustic signal sounds.

Information

- Navigation announcements and traffic notices are not issued during a dialogue.
- With voice control active, list entries can be selected via voice control, the rotary/push button or the touch display.
- If the spoken voice command is not understood or if it cannot be interpreted, voice control responds with the question **Excuse me?** and the voice command can then be repeated.

Notes on communication using voice control

Observe the following points when using voice control:

- Speak clearly and at a normal volume.
- Stress voice commands evenly, without long pauses in your speech.
- Reduce disruptive sounds, e.g. by closing doors, windows and the sliding roof.
- Voice control is optimised for the driver.

Using natural voice commands

Voice control is operated using natural voice commands and can work using various types of spoken commands.

- Use natural instructions, such as "Set air conditioning to 22 °C.", "Turn on Shiatsu massage." or "Drive me to Parliament Street, London."
- Say what you need, e.g. "There is a draft". Or "I need to fill up." or "I am hungry."
- Use situation-related voice commands, e.g. "Avoid a motorway." or "Search for a bakery along the route."
- Ask for information, e.g. "What's my range?" or "What's the weather like in London?"
- Use general search queries or questions, e.g. "What can I do in the Media area?" or "How does voice recognition work?"
- Use main functions, e.g. "I would like to see the map." or "Show my contacts."
- Use a destination from the map: Press your desired destination for longer and say "Hey Porsche, drive me there" Say .

General voice commands

The following voice commands can be said at any point in the dialogue:

- Correction
- Pause
- Cancel
- Help

Using lists by voice control

Browsing through lists

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Say **Next page/Previous page**.

Selecting an entry from the list

You can select line numbers and list entries displayed in blue in the PCM by saying them.

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Say **Line 1**.
– or –
Say a list entry.

Multimodal map



The Multimodal map allows interaction between voice control and the map during navigation. This enables faster and more varied searching by voice command.

When activated by voice control, it does not matter which menu is called up in the PCM.

Activate multimodal card using voice control

- ✓ Voice control is active.
- ▶ Say **I want to draw on the map**.
– or –
Say **Show me the multimodal card**.
- ➔ The map appears and displays a blue frame.

Activate multimodal card manually

1.  ▶ **Select Navigation** 
2. Start voice control.
- ➔ The map appears and displays a blue frame.

Example commands

These are not complete lists and show only some of the possible natural voice commands and instructions for the voice control system. A good data connection improves the search results and makes the search faster.

Air-conditioning system/Comfort functions

- Set seat heating to level 2.
- The windscreen is fogged.
- I would like a massage.
- Change the ambient light to red
- I will set the temperature in the back to 24 °C.
- Set the seat ventilation on the passenger side to level 2.

Navigation/while driving/Finder

- Drive me to the Porsche Museum.
- When do I need to refuel?
- Find a restaurant along the route/at the destination.
- How much longer will it take?
- Search for a car park.
- Drive me to work.
- Where have I driven to recently?
- Take me to the 911 road in Weissach.

Media

- Play the song "Get a Life", for example, from Porsche Sounds
- Play the album 'Bad' by Michael Jackson.
- What am I listening to now?
- I would like to search for music.
- Play Nelly Furtado in Apple Music.
- Play Classic FM.

- Next track.
- I would like to choose a different source.

Phone

- ✓ No phone call active.
- Please call John Doe
- Dial 020 911, for example.
- Try Andrew Forbes again.
- Show my calls.
- I would like to connect a new phone (only possible when stationary).

Reacting to previous dialogues

- ✓ Voice control is active.

Using other voice commands, you can get the system to react to an older dialogue of a main function (e. g. phone):

- Please call John Doe again.

Multimodal map



- ✓ Destination selected (pin set on map).
- Take me there.
- Find me a restaurant nearby.
- Find me bakeries nearby.
- Find me a post there.

Voice Control Help

The system can assist in different ways, questions can be asked or specific issues can be raised.

- I need help (general)
- How does voice control work?
- What can I do in the navigation area?
- What can you do?

Changing voice control settings

With the **Weather** service, weather information, e.g. at the destination, can be displayed in the Porsche Communication Management (PCM).

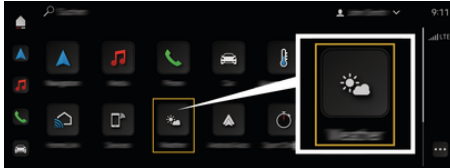


Fig. 16: Weather
